<p>Jaishankar bats for collective good in AI governance</p> <p>NEW DELHI, DHNS: The global governance of Artificial Intelligence (AI) must confront the temptation of a few nations to put self-interest above collective good, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar said.</p> <p>Jaishankar underlined the concerns about bias, ethics, privacy, and vulnerability arising out of the new frontier of technology and noted that 'trust and safety' were 'essential for the implementation of responsible AI'.</p> <p>Jaishankar was speaking at the Trust and Safety India Festival 2025, which is one of the preludes to the AI Impact Summit, which Prime Minister Narendra Modi will host in February 2026.</p> <p>"Technology is a force for good, but only if humanity guides it," Jaishankar quoted Modi saying.</p>	<p>While the US launched its AI Action Plan on July 23, China released its Action Plan for Global Artificial Intelligence Governance just three days later. President Donald Trump's administration focused on expanding the AI capabilities of the US and lessening regulations. The Chinese government, on the other hand, focused on expanding its influence in building the global AI governance architecture.</p> <p>"The different societies have put different levels of emphasis on the benefits and risks of AI... But at the end of the day, it is imperative that we take a sober and balanced view," he said.</p> <p>"After all, concerns about bias, ethics, privacy and vulnerability are well-founded, deriving from pre-existing experiences. We also need to take particular precautions against the danger of losing trust in institutions."</p>

EAM calls for implementation of 'Responsible AI'

New Delhi, 7 October

External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Tuesday observed that trust and safety are essential for the implementation of "Responsible AI" and underlined that for a society like India, this means the development of indigenous tools and frameworks, self-assessment protocols for innovators, and establishing relevant guidelines.

"Only then can we be assured that the development, deployment, use, and governance of AI is safe and accessible," he said in remarks at the "Trust & Safety India Festival 2025".

The minister said India bears a special responsibility because many other nations – especially those of the Global South – they look to the country for inspiration. "Certainly in the case of



the digital public infrastructure, today what we have achieved in the last decade, if you see today the scale of delivery, the improvement in governance, the efficiencies with which we serve the public, I think it is already resonating across the world," he said.

Talking about the future, the EAM said AI will transform economies in the next few years, change our work habits, create new health solutions, enhance educational access, improve efficiencies, and could even lead to a new lifestyle.

"The difference with the past is that this particular transformation that is going to come upon us – this will be all-pervasive and not just sectoral. It will impact every citizen in every corner of the world. New efficiencies and new possibilities will certainly emerge, but so too will new players and new power centres," he added.

For this very reason, he said the global community needs to adopt a balanced approach to the governance of AI and to ensure that there are adequate guardrails in place to protect digital nagriks. He quoted PM Modi in this regard to say: "Technology is a force for good, but only if humanity guides it."

"Indeed, every time a game-changing technology has appeared on the horizon, it has triggered off similar endeavours. But history is also a witness to the reality that those exercises have not been easy. There is the obvious temptation to put narrow self-interest above collective good. And that is why we need to rise to this particular challenge, because what is at stake cannot be overstated," he said.

India hosts first trust & safety festival

India on Tuesday hosted the inaugural Trust & Safety India Festival (TASI) 2025 in New Delhi, bringing together policymakers, technology leaders, academics and civil society representatives from over 15 countries to discuss challenges and opportunities in building safer digital spaces.

The two-day forum was inaugurated by External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar, and is jointly organised by the Centre for Social Research (CSR) and the Trust & Safety Forum. It is recognised as an official pre-event to the Government of India's AI Impact Summit 2026, scheduled for February next year. Addressing the gathering, Jaishankar said technology's "promise and perils have always been two sides of the same coin," and called for a balanced approach to AI governance with strong safeguards to protect citizens. He said India bears "special responsibility" as many nations,

particularly in the Global South, look to it for leadership.

Discussions at the festival covered a range of issues including tackling online child sexual abuse material (CSAM), combating misinformation and deepfakes, supporting survivors of non-consensual intimate image sharing, ensuring youth digital well-being, and addressing scams and abuse in encrypted spaces.

Dr. Ranjana Kumari, Director of CSR and Chairperson of the Alliance for Trust and Safety, said the festival represents "a movement for shared accountability and collective action," highlighting India's role as the world's largest democracy in promoting equitable digital governance.
