The Centre for Social Research (CSR), founded in 1983 in New Delhi, is a leading non governmental organization advancing gender justice and child protection through research, grassroots interventions, and policy advocacy. Over four decades, CSR has shaped both community practices and state, national, and regional policies. Its initiatives range from empowering women through leadership and governance training, to equipping young women in Haryana and Delhi with digital and professional skills for dignified employment, and enabling women in Rajasthan to lead climate-resilient water management. CSR also serves as a convener, bringing together government agencies, educators, civil society, and the private sector to strengthen frameworks on gender equity and child protection.

Since 2016, CSR has emerged as a pioneer in digital safety and online protection in India. It has directly trained more than 150,000 students, teachers, and parents, and reached over 400,000 people through outreach campaigns, educational resources, and media engagement. Working with partners such as Meta, Google, and Twitter/X, CSR has created curricula, toolkits, and youth-centered programs that enhance digital literacy, promote safe online behavior, and build resilience against cyber risks. By combining evidence, innovation, and advocacy, CSR continues to transform classrooms, communities, and digital platforms, ensuring safer, more equitable environments where women and children can thrive.
